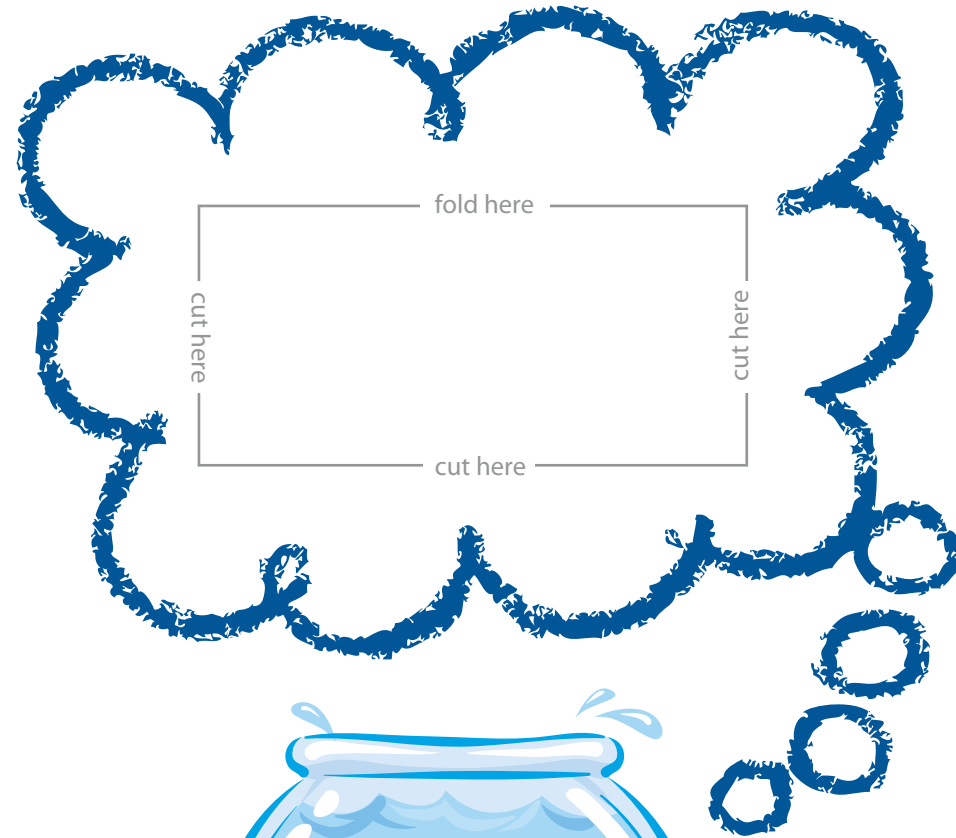




What's Dorothy thinking about?

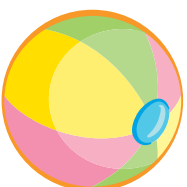
*It has a pillow

You sleep on it!*



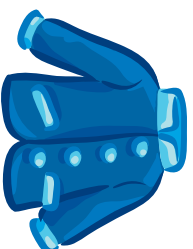
*It has four wheels

beep" and "vroom"!*



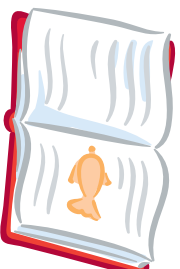
*It's round and it
